Pineapple and Pecan Cake

2 cups flour 2 cups sugar 2 tsp baking soda 2 eggs 1 20 oz. can crushed pineapple (do not drain) and 1-2 cups chopped pecans 350°Oven Spray a 9 X 13 pan

Mix dry ingredients then add eggs, pineapple and pecans. Pour into pan and bake 35 minutes or until toothpick comes out clean. Cool Completely.

Frosting

1 8 oz. cream cheese 1 stick butter (soften cheese and butter) 1 Tbsp. vanilla 2 cups Confectioner's Sugar

Cream cheese, butter and vanilla. Add sugar and beat well. Frost cake when it is completely cool.

Cherry Bubble

1 can Grands Biscuits 1 can Cherry Pie filling 1 Tbsp. milk 1/2 cup Powdered Sugar

350° oven; Bake 30 minutes

Butter a 9 x 13 pan; cut biscuits into pieces and place in bottom of pan. Pour Pie filling over biscuits and bake. Cool 10 minutes. Mix sugar and milk and drizzle over cherries.
