October 4, 2020: Eighteenth Sunday after Pentecost Isaiah 5:1-7 Psalm 80:7-15 Philippians 3:4b-14 Matthew 21:33-46	Jesus tells a parable to the religious leaders who are plotting his death, revealing that their plans will, ironically, bring about the fulfillment of the scripture
October 11, 2020: Nineteenth Sunday after Pentecost Isaiah 25:1-9 Psalm 23 Philippians 4:1-9 Matthew 22:1-14	Jesus tells a parable indicating that the blessings of God's kingdom are available to all, but the invitation is not to be taken lightly
October 18, 2020: Twentieth Sunday after Pentecost Isaiah 45:1-7 Psalm 96:1-13 I Thessalonians 1:1-10 Matthew 22:15-22	After Jesus begins teaching in the temple, religious leaders try to trap him with questions. First they ask if God's people should pay taxes to an earthly tyrant like Caesar.
October 25, 2020: Reformation Sunday Jeremiah 31:31-34 Psalm 46 Romans 3:19-28 John 8:31-36	Jesus speaks of truth and freedom as spiritual realities known through his word. HE reveals the truth that sets people free from sin.
